The DAAD is the world's largest funding organisation for the international exchange of students and researchers.

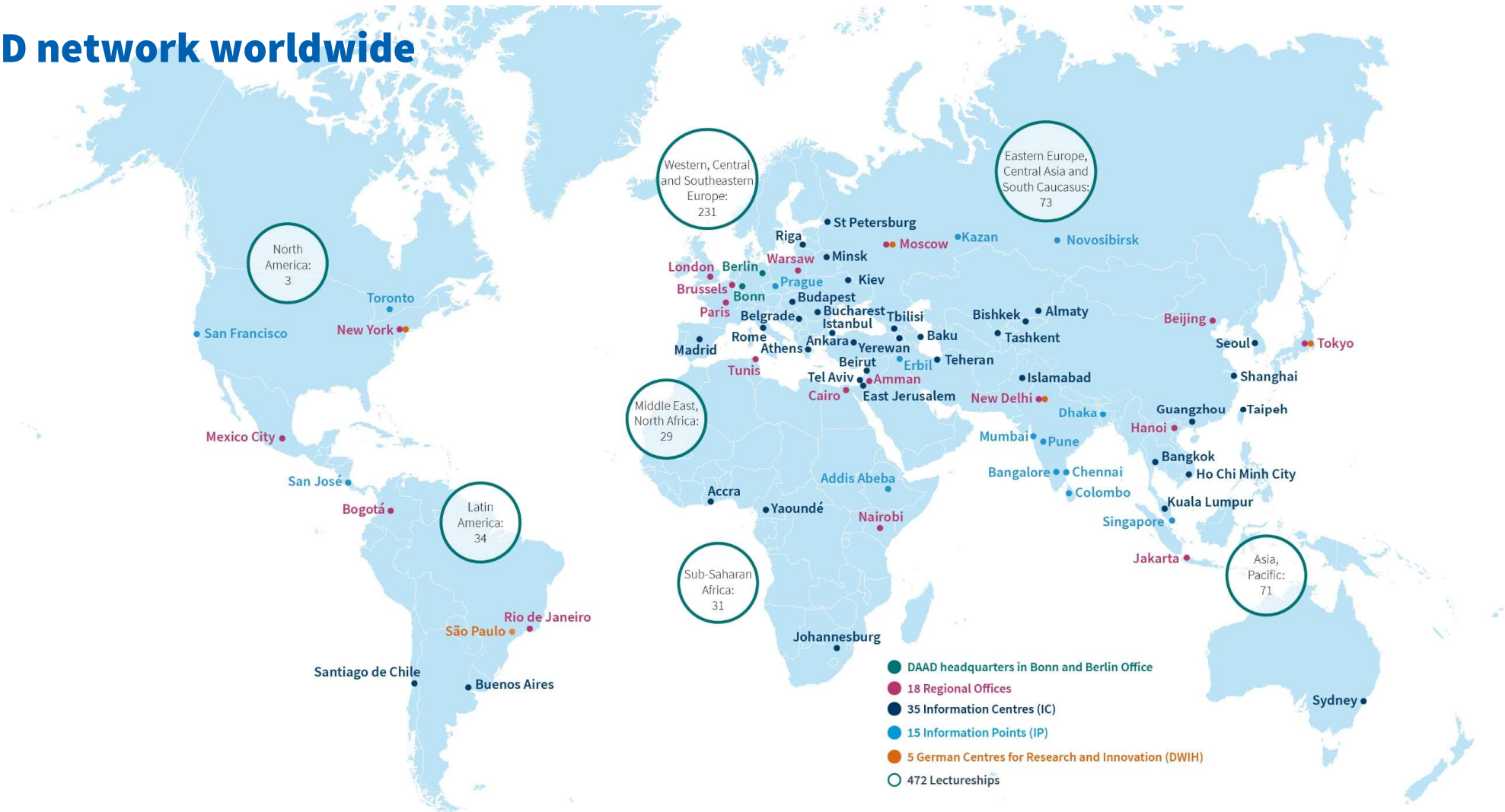

# DAAD Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Scientists

The programme provides funding for a research project or course of continuing scientific education at a state or state-recognised institution of higher education or a non-university research institute in Germany, which is being carried out in coordination with an academic adviser in Germany.

## - Short Term Research Grants

- Duration: **1-6 months**
- Deadlines: **April 30** (for projects starting from December) and **November 15** (projects starting from June)
- Monthly payments of **1,300 Euros** for doctoral candidates and PostDocs

## - One-Year Research Grants

- Duration: **7-12 months**
- Deadlines: **November 15** (projects starting from October of the following year)
- Monthly payments of **1,300 Euros** for doctoral candidates and PostDocs



# DAAD Research Grants for Doctoral Candidates and Young Scientists

## – Bi-Nationally Supervised Doctoral Degrees

This programme offers you the opportunity to do a bi-national doctoral degree at your home university and at a university in Germany.

### Option a) Doctorate with bi-national supervision:

Your doctoral project is supervised by a university teacher both at your home university and at the host institute in Germany (so-called 'sandwich model'). **Your project must be agreed with both supervisors.**

### Option b) Doctorate following the 'Cotutelle' procedure:

Funding is provided for doctoral projects that are carried out at the home university and at a university in Germany according to the so-called Cotutelle model. This is based on an **individual cooperation agreement which is concluded individually for your doctoral project by the participating universities**. After you have successfully completed your doctorate, the German university and your home university award the doctoral degree **jointly**.

- Duration: **7-24 months**
- Deadlines: **November 15**
- Monthly payments of **1,300 Euros**

## ERA Green Hydrogen Fellowships

Doctoral students and PostDocs from **various scientific disciplines** (natural and engineering sciences, economics and social sciences, logistics and law) whose **research focus is clearly related to the topic of "green hydrogen"** and can be assigned to one of the four working groups (production, transport/infrastructure, market stimulation, cross-cutting issues) are eligible to apply

- Duration: **1-18 months** for research fellowships and **2-3 months** for internships.
- Deadline: Applications can be submitted **anytime**, least 4 months before the planned starting date
- Monthly payments of **1,300 Euros** for PhD students, **2,800 Euros** for PostDocs

## DAAD offer for University Academics and Scientists

- **Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists**

This programme offers you the opportunity to network amongst colleagues and exchange experience in the framework of short-term research stays in Germany.

- **Working stays for university teaching staff – artistic subjects and architecture.**

The aim of this programme is to promote artistic cooperations with German host institutions. Funding is provided for study visits at state or state-recognised universities in Germany for artistic cooperations with a host institution.

- **Re-invitation for former scholarship holders**

This programme offers former scholarship holders the opportunity to carry out research and working projects in Germany and to maintain contacts as part of DAAD's global alumni network.

- Duration: **1-3 months** once within three years  
Deadlines: **April 30** (for projects starting from December) and **November 15** (projects starting from June)
- Monthly payments **of 2,000 euros** for assistant teachers, assistant professors and lecturers  
**2,150 euros** for professors

- Application and research project can be carried out in English and/or German (onSET Test)
- For applicants from the fields of human medicine, veterinary medicine and dentistry, other regulations are applicable [www.daad.de/extrainfo](http://www.daad.de/extrainfo)
- Confirmation from the academic host in Germany





## **Project Competition twice a year in March and October**

- The projects can represent **any scientific field** and can be carried out in different forms, such as seminars and guest lectures, research projects, conferences, publications etc.
- Support for projects, which promote the **scientific cooperation between Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania**, on the one hand, **and Germany**, on the other, and the cooperation between the Baltic States as well.
