We invite you to apply for the position of head of the Lithuanian Institute of History.

The mission of the Lithuanian Institute of History is the development of fundamental and applied research, studying the development of the Lithuanian nation, Lithuanian society, its culture, economy and statehood, to collect, systematise and disseminate documentary and intangible historical heritage; use the results of the study to contribute to the creation of civil society, the formation of public historical culture and critical discourse, and the preservation of cultural identity, together with universities to train history and ethnology researchers, form the strategy of Lithuanian history and ethnology sciences, actively participate in creating a knowledge society, and expand relations with the international research area.

The new head will supervise 112 employees, have the opportunity to seek additional funding (budget funding of the institute in 2023 – EUR 4.4 million, project funding – EUR 0.7 million), and develop the institute as the institution with the special national importance status.

We are looking for a head who will not only have a good understanding of the institute's mission, but will also be able to expand it as a leader.
