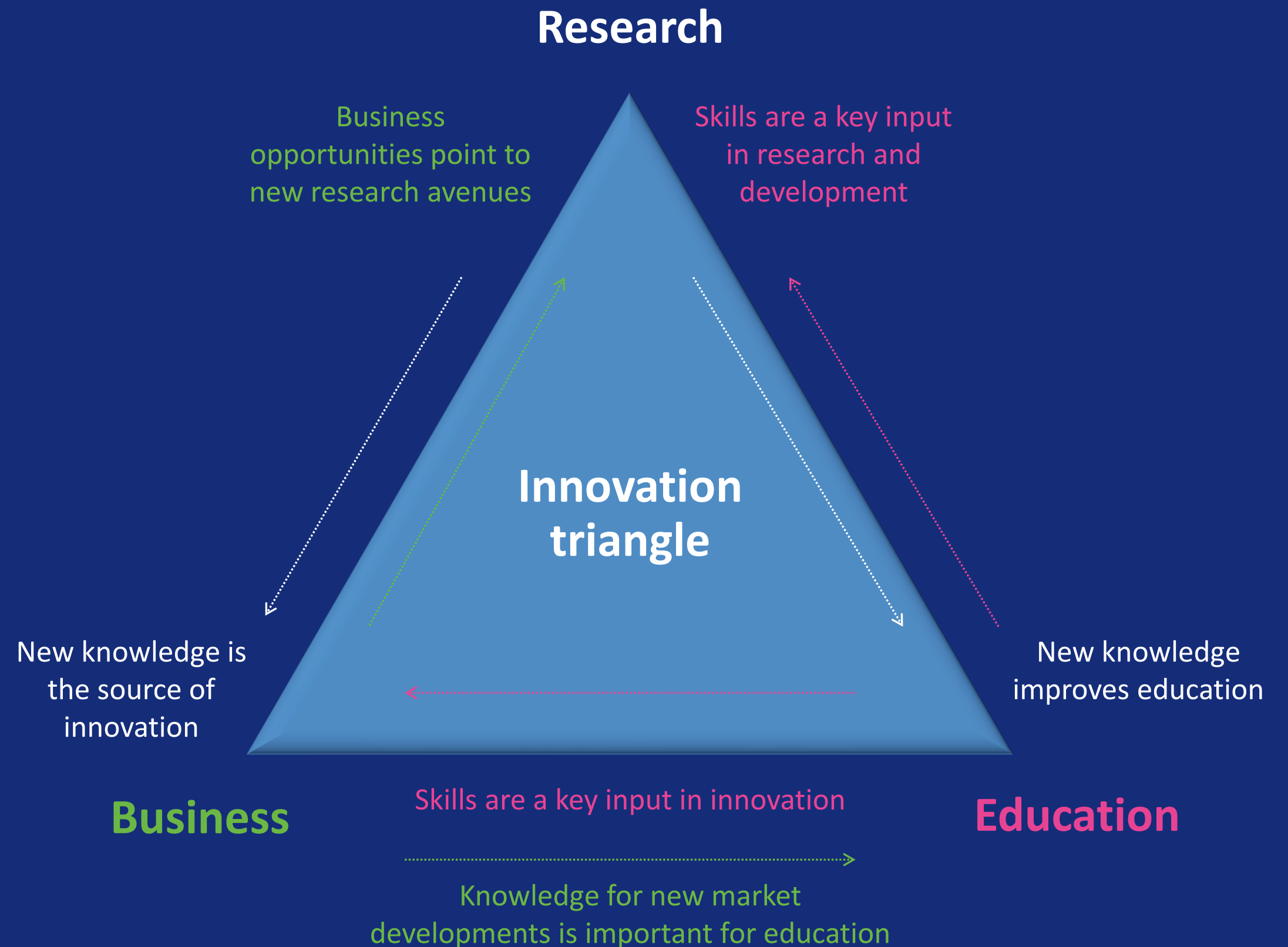

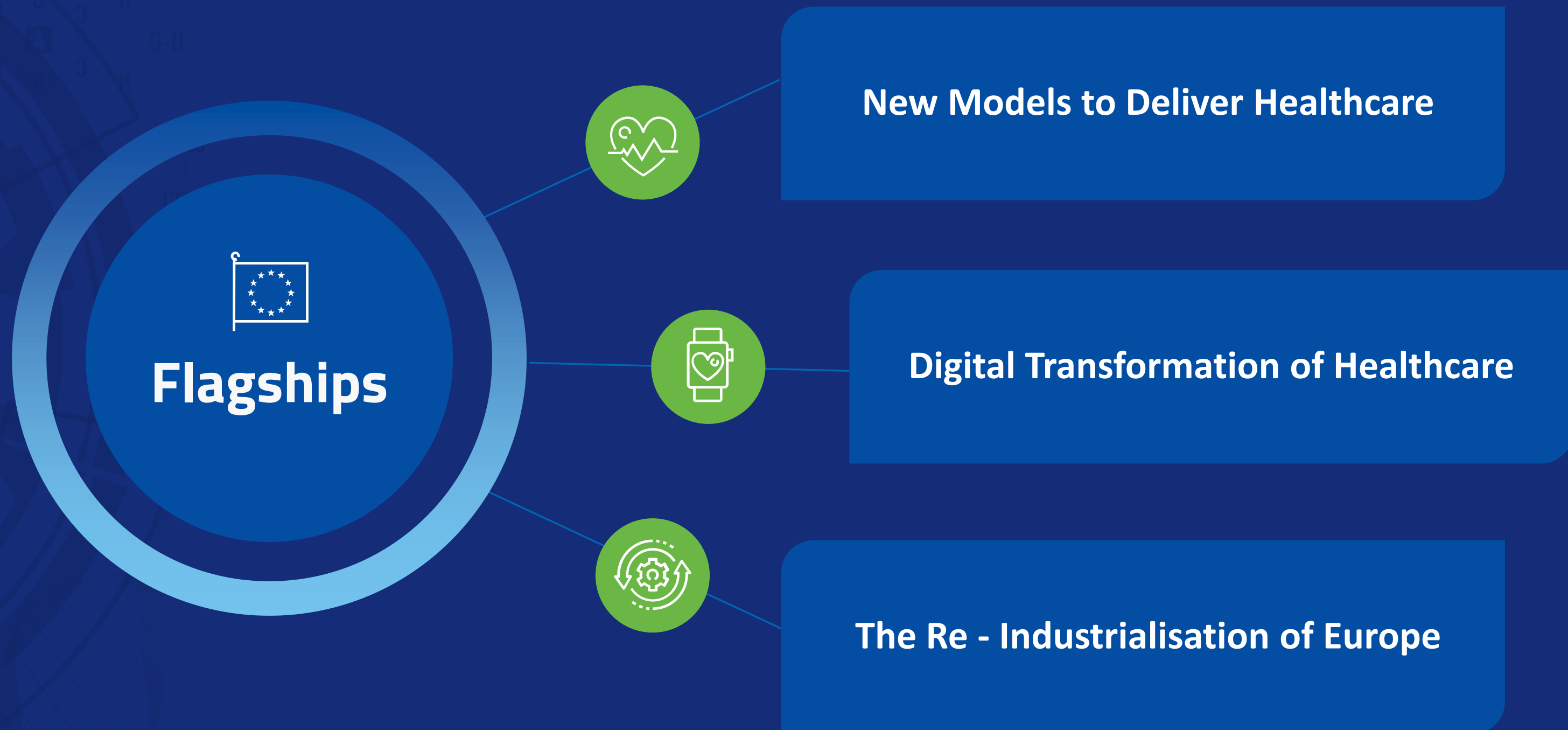


How do we make healthcare innovation happen together?

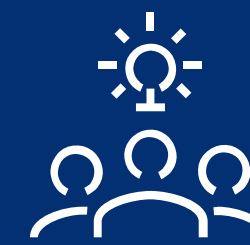

Mentoring Component

(1) Needs Assessment & Matching

- **Joint needs assessment** between RCL, the Learner and EIT Health to identify mentoring priorities.
- **Expert mentor matching** from EIT Health's network of 190+ healthcare innovation specialists.
- **Dedicated kick-off session** organised by EIT Health to align objectives, expectations and mentoring approach.

(2) Mentoring Delivery

- **10 hours of tailored mentoring** focused on the learner's specific challenge, project or development need.
- **Flexible scheduling**, agreed directly between the learner and mentor following the kick-off session.
- **Adaptable pace and format** based on agreed schedule, ranging from regular touchpoints throughout the programme to more intensive mentoring support over shorter periods.
- **Recommended alignment** between mentoring activities and the selected course pathway to maximise learning impact.

(3) Monitoring & Follow-Up

- **Course engagement tracking** through the EIT Health learning platform.
- **Mentor progress updates** captured by EIT Health throughout the mentoring journey.
- **Consolidated learner report** provided to RCL at programme closure, combining learning participation and mentoring engagement.

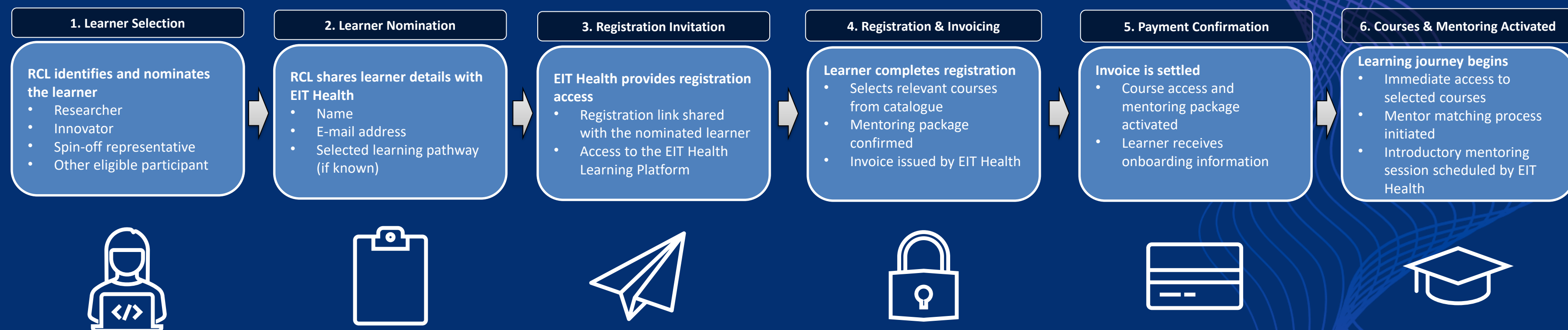

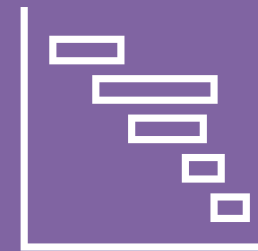


Typical activation time: access to courses and mentor matching is initiated immediately upon completion of registration and payment.

Digital Learning Analytics



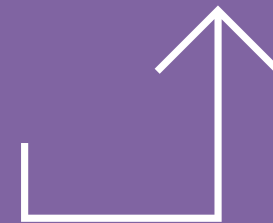
- **Real-time learner engagement tracking** through the EIT Health Learning Management System (LMS).
- **Monitoring of:**
 - course access and participation;
 - learning progress and completion rates;
 - time spent learning;
 - completion of course modules and activities.
- **Monthly frequency:**
 - high-level data and insights reports provided to the RCL monthly during the programme duration, in the appropriate format.

Mentoring Progress Monitoring



- Mentors provide **structured progress updates** on learner engagement and development throughout the mentoring journey.
- Tracking of:
 - mentoring hours delivered;
 - key discussion topics;
 - learner progress against objectives;
 - overall participation and engagement.

Consolidated Reporting to the RCL



- **Final programme report** prepared by EIT Health.
- Combined overview of:
 - course participation and learning analytics;
 - mentoring activity and utilisation;
 - learner engagement and progress;
 - programme-level participation summary across the RCL cohort.
